Worship services are held on Sundays at First Baptist Church California unless the weather is unquestionably inclement to the point of becoming dangerous. Although it is not possible to define prohibitive weather with a list of identifiable characteristics, elements taken into consideration for cancellation include the timing of the inclement weather, the condition of the parking lot, amount of snow, and/or ice, and dangerous temperatures. Should the need for cancellation arise, these guidelines will be followed:

- *The Pastor, Chairman of Deacons, Sunday school director, Minister of Music, and Minister of Youth shall be consulted should the need to cancel services arise. The Pastor shall serve as the Chairman of this group and consult with each individual before the group makes a final decision.*
- *Should the need to cancel Sunday morning services arise, the cancellation announcement will be given to KRLI radio station, and when feasible, T.V. Channel 13 KRCC. If possible, a staff member will place the announcement on the telephone message at the church. Church members may try to call the church for this word at 796-4452.*
- *Should the need to cancel Sunday morning services arise, a tape from an earlier service in the year will air on KRLI during the regular worship hour at 10:30 so that members of the congregation can worship through the radio ministry.*
- *Should the need to cancel Sunday evening services arise, the announcement will be made either at the conclusion of the morning worship hour, or placed on KRLI and the church telephone message as soon in the afternoon as the decision is made. Members of the congregation should listen to KRLI, or may call the church for this word at 796-4452.*
